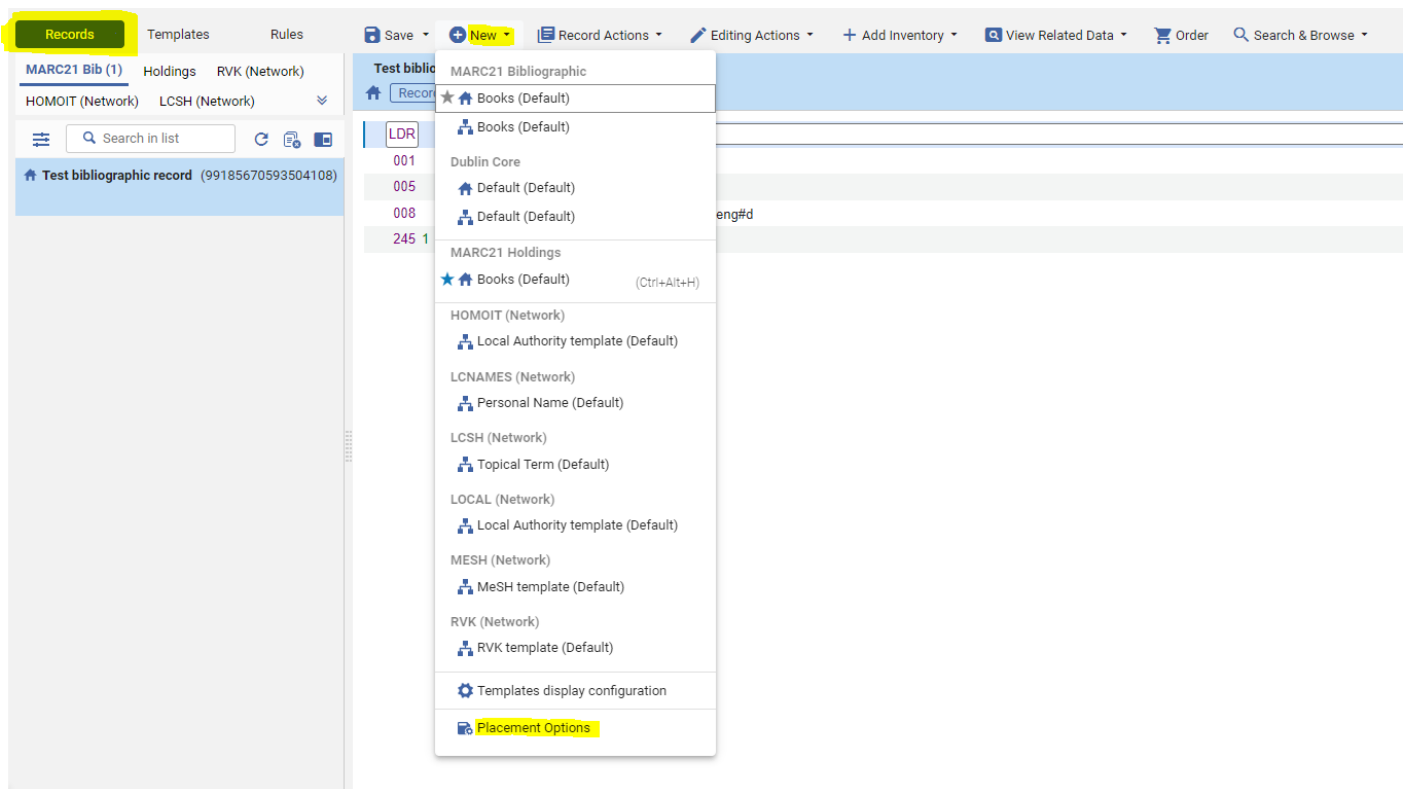


How to create new bibliographic records in the Metadata Editor

1. Open the Metadata Editor.
2. Choose *Records* on the top left-hand corner, then choose *New > Placement Options*.



3. Choose the location of new records (whether IZ-only or liked to the NZ). Then click Save; this setting will be saved until you change the setting again.

4. Choose New > MARC21 Bibliographic > Books (Default)
